

Parking During the 2018 Golf Tournament at Torrey Pines

The annual PGA golf tournament at Torrey Pines will be played on Thursday, January 25 through Sunday, January 28. Although heavier traffic will occur on the surrounding public streets, the San Diego Police Department has confirmed that vehicular access to the Consortium will be maintained.

Consistent with prior years, some parking spaces in the Consortium's lots will be sold to the tournament's organizers to generate revenue that defrays many expenses associated with refreshments served at Consortium symposia and events throughout the year.

Consequently, the following parking changes at the Consortium will be in effect on January 25-28.

- On Thursday and Friday (January 25-26), the West Lot will be used by Uber vehicles that will enter the West lot directly from Torrey Pines Scenic Drive. The East Lot will be available for anyone with a Sanford East Lot permit, and those with both Sanford West Lot and UCSD permits. People with Sanford permits who use 'early bird' parking will be redirected to the adjacent UCSD gravel lot.

- On Saturday and Sunday (January 27-28), the 60 parking spaces in the easternmost bay in the East Lot will be reserved for use by Consortium faculty, staff, and students who have valid Sanford parking permits, as well as patrons of the Bella Vista café. The remaining spaces in both lots will be used to generate parking revenue.

As was the case during last year's tournament, it is expected that appropriate parking will be available for all Consortium personnel, and access problems are not anticipated. Finally, in addition to paying the Sanford Consortium for the use of our parking lots during the golf tournament, the organizers have provided a limited number of free tickets that will be valid for any one-day from January 25-28, 2018. Two tickets per person are available on a first come, first serve basis at the front desk. If you're interested, bring your SCRM ID to the front desk and get a couple while the supply lasts!
